5.1 Request for No Parking-Dead End at the Northern end of Nottingham Avenue (Kim Aleman, Merced, CA)

Staff reviewed the request and discussed options available to alleviate the parking issue at the dead end of Nottingham Avenue.

M/S STRUBLE-HAMILTON, and carried by unanimous voice vote, to recommend to City Council installation of a 10' bike lane down the east side of Nottingham Avenue from Brookdale Drive to the entrance to Rahilly Park in addition to posting "No Parking at Any Time" signs only on the east side.

5.2 Request for No Parking on Santa Fe Avenue at the intersection of Santa Fe Avenue and Glen Avenue (Abe Ochoa, Merced, CA)

Staff reviewed the request for No Parking on Santa Fe Avenue and discussed options.

M/S HAMILTON-STRUBLE, and carried by unanimous voice vote, to recommend to City Council a red "No Parking" zone on the north side of Santa Fe Avenue from Glen Avenue to the southeast corner of the Hoover Junior High School property line.
