ORDINANCE NO. 2415

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230, "NO PARKING ZONES," AND 10.28.231, "NO TRUCK PARKING ZONES," OF THE MERCED MUNICIPAL CODE (X STREET)

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.230, "No Parking Zones," of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting the following portion of the following streets:

<u>"Street</u>	<u>Portion</u>
East side of X Street	Commencing at the south line of West 13th Street, thence southerly 150 feet"

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.230, "No Parking Zones," of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following streets:

<u>"Street</u>	<u>Portion</u>
East side of X Street	Commencing at the south line of West 13th Street, thence southerly 10 feet and stopping; thence resuming 65 feet from the original commencement point to 150 feet from the original commencement point"

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.231, "No Truck Parking Zones," of the Merced Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following streets:

"Street	<u>Portion</u>
East side of X Street	Beginning at the north line of State Route 140, thence northerly to the northerly end of X Street at West 13th Street"

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 6. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.
