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## GENERAL INFORMATION

Any documents provided to a majority of the Commissioners after this agenda is posted will be available for public inspection in the Planning Department during normal business hours.

## THE DESIGN REVIEW COMMISSION

The Design Review (DRC)/Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) performs comprehensive site plan and architectural review within the Downtown Redevelopment Project Area in order to promote orderly development of the City and stability of land values and investments. The DRC also serves as the Historic Preservation Commission established to promote the protection, enhancement, perpetuation, and use of structures, sites, and areas that are reminders of past eras, events, and persons important to local, state, or national history. Meetings are normally held at 4:00 p.m. on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of the month (except for those months when the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month falls on a Tuesday or Wednesday, then the DRC meets on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the month), in addition to special meetings as called. ## DESIGN REVIEW/HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MEETINGS

The Commissioners are interested in your views and want to hear them. The Commission will ask those who are for\* or against\*\* a proposal to speak at all Final Reviews. The sequence of events is:

1. Staff report of facts and a recommendation.
2. Applicant's statement.
3. Proponents\* of the proposal.
4. Opponents\*\* of the proposal.
- (5. If necessary, a summary statement or rebuttal from the applicant.)

If you decide to speak, please submit a "Request to Speak" form prior to the start of the public hearing. You will be called up to speak at the appropriate time by the Recording Secretary. Please start by giving your name and city of residence, then tell the Commissioners your concern. We want your views; don't worry about how to say them. If several people have spoken, try not to be repetitious. If there are several in your area with concerns, why not appoint a spokesman. The Commission is particularly interested in the specific reasons you are for or against a proposal because their decision has to be based on specific reasons.
