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Application and Ordinance Structure

All commercial cannabis activities required to have a Commercial Cannabis Business Permit (CCBP):

- Appropriate land use permit (likely a CUP)
- Compliant with all local regulations
- Compliant with all State regulations
- Pay all associated fees
- Submit all required documents



Application Selection Components

- Location
- Neighborhood Compatibility Plan with Outreach Component
- Air Quality Plan
- Local Enterprise
- Qualifications of Principals
- Prior Experience in Dispensary Ownership/Management
- Applicant pays a living wage (at least 150% of the Federal Poverty Level for a family of four)
- Applicant provides employer paid health insurance benefits for its employees
- Standards and procedures for the safe operation of its facilities and engages employees on best practices
- Applicant provides training and educational opportunities for employee development
- Applicant or entity has no previous record of violating federal or state laws relating to workplace safety




Application Selection Components

- Measuring and improving customer satisfaction
- History of bankruptcy by the applicant or entities owned or operated by the applicant;
- Educating patients on how marijuana can be used to assist patients with debilitating medical conditions and about the marijuana and manufactured marijuana products that will be available in the applicant's retail dispensing locations
- Producing and maintaining a supply of marijuana that is sufficient to meet the needs of qualifying patients
- Providing safe, accessible retail dispensing locations
- Good credit history
- Applicant provides proof of financial stability and access to financial resources



Health and Safety Ordinance Components

- Track and trace
- Testing
- Security and safety
- Labelling and packaging
- Parking/handicapped access
- Cash management
- Delivery – how much product/how much money
- Disposal
