**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,  
AMENDING SECTIONS 10.28.230, “NO PARKING  
ZONES,” AND 10.28.370, “TWO-WAY STOP  
INTERSECTIONS,” OF THE MERCED  
MUNICIPAL CODE**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN  
AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.230 of the Merced Municipal Code dealing with no parking zones is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following streets:

<u>“Street</u>	<u>Portion</u>
West side of V Street	Beginning at the northern curb return of West 20th Street, thence northerly 20 feet
East side of V Street	Beginning at the southern curb return of West 20th Street, thence southerly 20 feet
North side of West 25th Street	Beginning at western return of R Street, thence westerly 15 feet
South side of West 25th Street	Beginning at western curb return of R Street, thence westerly 21 feet”

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO CODE.** Section 10.28.370 of the Merced Municipal Code dealing with two-way stop intersections is hereby amended by adding the following street segment:

“Approaching streets required  
to stop

West 7th Street

At any entrance thereof with

Canal Street”

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

**SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

**SECTION 5. PUBLICATION.** The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.
