

ORDINANCE NO. 2429

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTION 10.28.230 OF THE
MERCED MUNICIPAL CODE DEALING WITH
NO PARKING ZONES (CHILDS AVENUE,
GROGAN AVENUE AND WEST AVENUE)**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MERCED DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CODE. Section 10.28.230 of the Merced Municipal Code dealing with no parking zones is hereby amended by adding the following portion of the following streets:

<u>“Street</u>	<u>Portion</u>
South side of Grogan Avenue	Beginning at the western return of West Avenue, thence westerly 170 feet
East side of West Avenue	Beginning at the northern return of West 2nd Street, thence northerly 130 feet
North side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the eastern return of West Avenue, thence easterly 455 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of South S Street, thence westerly 150 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of South R Street, thence westerly 453 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the eastern return of South R Street, thence westerly 370 feet

North side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of Q Street, thence westerly 225 feet
North side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the eastern return of Q Street, thence easterly 967 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of South M Street, thence westerly 165 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the eastern return of South M Street, thence westerly 372 feet
North side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of West 5th Street, thence westerly 200 feet
North side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of Martin Luther King Jr. Way, thence westerly 215 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the western return of South G Street, thence westerly 1,383 feet
South side of Childs Avenue	Beginning at the eastern return of South G Street, thence easterly 1,575"

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or

portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. PUBLICATION. The City Clerk is directed to cause a summary of this Ordinance to be published in the official newspaper at least once within fifteen (15) days after its adoption showing the vote thereon.


