NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Merced City Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, June 20, 2016, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Merced City Council Chambers, Merced Civic Center, 678 W. 18th Street, Merced, CA, to consider a proposed 2-year suspension of collecting the Regional Transportation Impact Fees and to consider the introduction of an Ordinance entitled:

**“AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF MERCED, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING  
SECTION 17.64.150, “REPEAL,” OF THE MERCED  
MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO THE REGIONAL  
TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEE”**

The public is invited to provide any oral or written comments regarding this proposed Ordinance.

**If adopted, this Ordinance would suspend for 2 years, or until June 20, 2018, the City’s collection of the Regional Transportation Impact Fees on all new development projects (including residential, commercial, and industrial projects).**
