# Some Proposition 64 Highlights

- AUMA Allows Adult-Use Recreational
- 57% support
- Must be 21 years old
- Indoor cultivation of 6 plants for personal use allowed
- Outdoor cultivation may be prohibited
- Adults may possess 28.5 grams of cannabis plant material and 8 grams of concentrate
- Allows local taxation and regulation
- State excise tax of 15% on the average market price of commercial medical and recreational
- State cultivation tax of \$9.25 on flower/\$2.75 on non-flower plant leaf for commercial medical and recreational





# Some MAUCRSA Highlights

- Creates the Bureau of Cannabis Control
- Allows vertical integration of everything but testing



- Eliminates transportation licenses
- Allows special permits for county fairs and agricultural events for the sale and onsite consumption of cannabis
- Provides a CEQA exemption for localities that require discretionary approval for permitting a commercial cannabis business

# The Three Basic Elements of the Cannabis Industry

Retail and Delivery





Cultivation



Manufacturing



# Delivery vs Distribution

Delivery means bringing product to the consumer.



Distribution means transporting product between commercial licensees.







## Types of Manufacturing Licenses

- Type 7 Manufacturing Volatile
  - Hexane, butane, etc.
- Type 6 Manufacturing Non Volatile
  - Water, CO<sub>2</sub>
- Type P Manufacturing
  - Packaging or repackaging
  - Labeling or relabeling
- Type N
  - Infusion process (non-extraction)
  - Edibles, tinctures





# If State-Issued Card Required: Medicinal vs Adult Use

- Accessibility
  - Adult use open to all
  - Medicinal use open to card holders only
- Projected Revenue
  - Medicinal only 16 card holders
- Premises
  - Co-join allowed
  - Separation required

## Ordinance Structure

#### Two elements:

All commercial cannabis activities required to have:

- 1. Commercial Cannabis Business Permit (CCBP)
- 2. Land Use Approval

2. Commercial Cannabis Business Permit (CCBP)


#### Components

- Compliant with all local regulations
- Compliant with all State regulations
- Pay all associated fees
- Submit all required documents
- Zoning Verification Form

## How Much Revenue?




- SCI's rule-of-thumb revenue formula:
  - Based upon statewide empirical analysis

Predicted annual general fund revenue = (Agency Population) \* (\$10 to \$20)


#### Example:

- City Population = 100,000
- Annual Tax = \$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000

## Taxation for General Fund Revenue

- General fund enhancement through taxation
- Requires balloted tax measure
- Tax Methodology
  - Gross receipts
  - Square footage
  - Inventory weight
  - other







# Manufacturing and Dispensary Taxes in Other Localities

- Calaveras County 7% Dispensaries 7%
- Carson= 18%
- Cloverdale, Ca = 10%
- Coachella, Ca = \$15 s/f Dispensaries 6%
- Greenfield, Ca = 10%
- Grover Beach = 5% medical; 10% non-medical
- Hayward = 15%





## Cultivation Taxes in Other Localities

• Carson, Ca = \$25 s/f



- Cloverdale, Ca = 10% of Gross Receipts
- Coachella, Ca = \$15 s/f
- Greenfield, Ca = \$25 s/f
- Grover Beach, Ca = \$25 first 5,000 s/f; \$10 s/f after that
- Hayward, Ca = 15% of Gross Receipts
- King City, Ca = \$25 first 5,000 s/f; \$10 s/f after that



## How Much Taxation?

Merced sales tax: 8.25%

+



AUMA 15% Gross Receipts (average market price)

+

- AUMA \$9.25/oz. on flower + \$2.75/oz. on non-flower plant leaf
- Local commercial cannabis taxes (5% to 20%)
