The HUD Annual Action Plan identifies funding priorities and details the projects proposed to receive Federal funds under the CDBG and HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) Programs.

- *A public hearing will be held at the City Council at 7 p.m., Monday, April 16, 2018 for final adoption of the HUD Annual Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2018/19.*
- *There are also three community meetings (Thursday November 30, 2017; Tuesday, January 9, 2018; and, Thursday February 1, 2018) and at City Council meetings. The agendas for the Council meetings will be posted online at the City website.*
