

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
FOR CERTIFICATION OF THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE
WELL 3 TANK DEMOLITION PROJECT, MAKING FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS,
ADOPTION OF A STATEMENT OF OVERRIDING CONSIDERATIONS, AND ADOPTION
OF A MITIGATION MONITORING PROGRAM

A public hearing will be held by the Merced City Council on Monday, August 20, 2018, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard in the City Council Chambers located in the Civic Center at 678 W. 18th Street, Merced, California, concerning the Certification of the Final Environmental Impact Report for the Well 3 Tank Demolition Project, initiated by the City of Merced, property owner. This project involves the demolition of an inactive 300,000-gallon, riveted steel water tank, generally located at the northwest corner of West 12th Street and Canal Street within a Medium Density Residential (R-3-1.5) zone; said property being more particularly described as Lots 29, 30, 31, and 32 of Block 252 on that map entitled "Town of Merced," recorded in Volume 2, Page 12 of Merced County Records; also known as Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 031-321-015.

A final environmental impact report (EIR) has been prepared for this project. A copy of this EIR is available for public inspection at the City of Merced Planning Department during regular business hours, at 678 W. 18th Street, Merced, California. A copy of this document can also be purchased at the Planning Department for the price of reproduction.
