New Carrier to Serve Merced



On October 10, 2007, the US Department of Transportation named Great Lakes Airlines as the successful bidder to replace Air Midwest Airlines in Merced and Visalia.

New service is expected

Great Lakes Airlines (GLA) is based in Cheyenne, Wyoming. GLA proposes to start service in Merced with three daily non-stop flights to Las Vegas McCarran Airport, also providing local passengers easy connections to other

Airline Service Continues from Merced

Great Lakes also has 30 seat Brasilia Aircraft, complete with a lavatory and flight attendant onboard.

Vision Airlines, which was also a bidder for the Merced EAS service, continues to negotiate with the City of Merced regarding possible new service to several other regional destinations.

Vision Airlines currently operates as a non-scheduled charter airline, but plans in the near future to obtain a full air carrier operating certificate.

Airport Projects

Several projects are under way at the Merced Municipal Airport:

A major [irrigation and storm water drainage](#) project that is funded through a combined FAA grant and City matching funds is nearing completion. The project caused a temporary displaced threshold of 1400' on the approach end of Runway 30.

Full use of the runway will resume on Tuesday the 13th of November.

The Airport [emergency generator](#) will have additional equipment

added soon, equipping the generator to handle all power outages.

A new [Airport Maintenance Building](#) is in design, allowing the airport to store equipment out of the elements.

Also, the [Airport taxiways and GA tarmac](#) will be crack sealed and all taxiway and hold lines will be refreshed in the very near future.

The [newest corporate hangar](#) at the Airport is now complete and ready for move in.
