Code-share partners With Frontier and United



Great Lakes Airlines has notified the City of Merced that service will begin soon for the cities of Merced County and the surrounding communities.

Although Great Lakes expected to start much earlier in the year, unforeseen delays have occurred. Recently, Great Lakes has worked out arrival and depart-

ure gate access and baggage handling issues with McCarran Airport in Las Vegas.

As of today, Great Lakes Airlines expects to start service around May 1st. As with any new plan, there are numerous items to coordinate and secure in order to start.

In the meantime, Mesa Airlines will continue to serve Merced.

Great Lakes will provide service to McCarran Airport in Las Vegas – the busiest airport in the West. Since they “Code Share” with United and Frontier, travelers can book flights anywhere in the world directly from Merced.

Airport Projects

Several projects are under way at the Merced Municipal Airport:

A major [irrigation and storm water drainage](#) project that is funded through a combined FAA grant and City matching funds is completed.

The Airport [emergency generator](#) equipment has been added, which equips the Airport to handle all power outages.

A new [Airport Maintenance Building](#) is in design, allowing the airport to store equipment out of the elements.

A new [modular building](#) is being considered for the Airport Terminal. This new building will provide a new entrance to the terminal that is ADA compliant in addition to providing needed space until the new terminal is built.

Also, the [Airport taxiways and GA tarmac](#) will be crack sealed and all taxiway and hold lines will be refreshed in the near future.
