Airport Projects

Floyd Johnston Construction was awarded the contract by the City Council on July 7 for the final phase of pipelining irrigation and drainage canals on the Airport. Construction has begun and is going according to plan.

Viking General Contractors, Inc. was awarded the contract by the City Council on July 7 to construct the new Airport Storage-Maintenance Building and related paving. The 2,000 square foot metal building will be located off Fly-In Way, behind Hangar 16. Construction begins October 13.

Bret-Briggs Construction was selected by Airport Staff for the ADA renovations at the Airport main terminal. These renovations involve the bathrooms and main entrance ramp. Construction is now in its final stages and should be completed before the end of October.

Gateway Aviation's twenty new general aviation hangars are complete. Currently, thirteen of these hangars have been leased. The City is exercising its option to purchase these hangars – January 1, 2009 is the target date for acquisition.
